

Data privacy information - pursuant to EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) for visitors to the Bankathon website

The following data protection information provides an overview of the processing of your data as a visitor to our website

In the following information we would like to give you an overview of the processing of your personal data by us and your rights under data protection law.

<p>1. Who is responsible for data processing and who can I contact?</p>	<p>The controller is: finleap connect GmbH Gausstrasse 190 c 22765 Hamburg</p> <p>You can contact our data protection officer at: Phone: +49 40-540 90 97 87 as well as via e-mail.</p>
<p>2. What sources and data do we use? (categories of personal data/ type of data)</p>	<p>We process personal data that we receive within the scope of your use of the Bankathon website. In addition to personal data transmitted by you through the use of the contact form, we also process a little other data that is automatically transmitted to us by your browser, e.g. your IP address. We need these exclusively to ensure the functionality of our website. Relevant personal data is data from the contact form, as well as the IP address.</p>
<p>3. What do we process your data for (purpose of processing) and on what legal basis?</p>	<p>We process your data to enable you to use the Bankathon website. Your personal data is processed in accordance with the General Data Processing Regulation (GDPR) and the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) and sector-specific data protection standards.</p>
<p>3.1. In respect of the fulfilment of contractual obligations</p>	<p>There is no processing of personal data to fulfil contractual obligations for the use of this website.</p>
<p>3.2. In the context of weighing up interests</p>	<p>If necessary, we also process your data to safeguard our legitimate interests (Art. 6 Para. 1 f EU GDPR) or those of third parties. For example, to ensure the reliable operation of our website (IP address).</p>
<p>3.3. On the basis of your consent</p>	<p>If you have given us your consent to process personal data for specific purposes, this processing is legal on the basis of your consent (Art. 6 Para. 1 a GDPR). A given consent can be revoked at any time. This also applies to the revocation of declarations of consent. Please note that the revocation is only effective for the future. Processing that took place before the revocation is not affected by this.</p>

3.4. On the basis of statutory regulations	Your personal data will not be processed on the basis of statutory requirements.
4. Who will receive my data?	<p>Within the company, the data will be provided to those departments which need it to fulfil your request. Contractors used by us may also receive data for these purposes. They are contractually bound to the same data protection standards, may only process your personal data to the same extent and for the same purposes as we are and are subject to our instructions. These can be companies in the categories of accounting, IT services, logistics and telecommunications.</p> <p>With regard to the transfer of data to other recipients outside the company (in addition to the order processors), it must first be noted that we comply with the applicable data protection regulations. In addition, we may only disclose your data if required to do so by law, if you have given your consent or if we are authorised to provide information. Under these conditions, recipients of personal data may be public authorities and institutions (offices, authorities, etc.), for example, if a legal or official obligation exists.</p>
5. How long will my data be stored?	<p>If necessary, we process and store your personal data within the scope of our privacy policy that can be accessed on our website at any time. The storage period for the IP address, for example, is 31 days.</p> <p>As soon as the storage of the data is no longer necessary to answer your enquiry, your data will be deleted immediately.</p>
6. Is data transferred to a third country or to an international organisation?	<p>Data will only be transferred to third countries (countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA)) or international organisations if you have given your consent or in the context of order processing. If third party service providers are deployed, they will be required to comply with data protection standards in Europe in addition to written instructions through the Privacy Shield scheme or agreement on EU standard contractual clauses.</p> <p>We will inform you separately about details, if required by law.</p>
7. What data protection rights do I have?	<p>Every data subject has the right of access to the processing of their personal data, the right to rectification, the right to erasure, the right to limitation of processing, the right to object to processing and the right to data transferability within the limits of the law. In addition, there is a right of appeal to a data protection supervisory authority.</p>
8. Is there an obligation for me to provide data?	<p>When you visit this website, you only need to provide the personal data that is necessary to ensure the operation of the website (e.g. IP address) or to the collection of which we are legally obliged. In addition, when using the contact form, you only provide us with the data you enter there.</p>

9. To what extent is there automated decision making in individual cases?	We do not use processes for automated decision making in connection with customer relations.
10. To what extent is my data used for profile formation (scoring)?	We do not process data for profile building.

Information about your right of objection

Right of objection on a case-by-case basis

You have the right to object at any time for reasons arising from your particular situation to the processing of personal data concerning you, which is based on data processing in the public interest and data processing on the basis of a balance of interests.

The responsible party will no longer process the personal data that concerns you, unless the party can prove compelling legitimate reasons for the processing, which outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.
